Cash rewards are paid for tips that lead to the arrest and charges filed against suspects who abuse and steal from seniors.



HOW IT WORKS

When you call 1-800-222-TIPS⁽⁸⁴⁷⁷⁾ you will speak with a trained call receiver assigned to Crime Stoppers.

THE CALL IS CONFIDENTIAL. THERE ISN'T CALLER-ID ON THE LINE, AND THEY WON'T TRY TO FIND OUT WHO YOU ARE.

Instead of your name the call receiver will give you a unique tip number, that's it. The number is all you need to identify yourself and collect your reward.
