## **PEDESTRIAN HIT & RUN**



The Pierce County Sheriff's Department needs your help to identify the pictured suspect, who is believed to be responsible for a hit and run that injured a pedestrian.

At approximately 9:20 p.m. on Monday July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017, a woman was struck by an unidentified vehicle as she was walking along the shoulder in the 400 block of 106<sup>th</sup> St. S. in Parkland.

A blue SUV traveling on 106<sup>th</sup> St. struck the victim, knocked her off the ground, and continued heading westbound without stopping. The victim suffered multiple scrapes and lacerations from the impact.

A witness saw the pictured male suspect leave a nearby marijuana shop on Pacific Ave. and enter a newer small dark blue SUV with a silver bumper (possibly a Toyota RAV4 or similar compact SUV). The suspect was observed driving westbound on 106<sup>th</sup> just before the witness heard the impact of the car hitting the victim.
